Corrected Credit Index

Establishment of Students' Tuition Fees

(1) Calculation of the Credit Index:

$$ci = \sum (\text{grades} \times \text{credits}) / 30$$

(2) Calculation of the Corrected Credit Index (ci-corr):

$$ci\text{-corr} = ci \times (\text{number of completed credits}) / (\text{number of enrolled credits})$$

(3) The amount of the tuition fee does not depend on the grade point average achieved by the student¹.

[2023. [Valid until 31 July 2023!]² (4) The **amount of tuition fee**³, effective uniformly from 1 February 2014, is as follows:⁴

1. BA full-time programme: HUF 180,000.
2. BA evening programme: HUF 140,000.
3. MA full-time programme: HUF 240,000.
4. MA evening programme: HUF 190,000.⁵
5. BA partial studies: from the autumn semester of 2021/2022: HUF 6,000 per enrolled credit, but minimum HUF 15,000/semester for evening programme and minimum HUF 20,000/semester for full-time programme.⁶
6. MA partial studies: from the autumn semester of 2021/2022: HUF 6,000 per enrolled credit, but minimum HUF 25,000/semester for evening programme and minimum HUF 30,000/semester for full-time programme.⁷
7. Higher Education Vocational Training: from the autumn semester of 2022/2023: HUF 135,000/semester.⁸
8. Correspondence programme: from the autumn semester of 2022/2023: HUF 210,000/semester.⁹
9. Distance learning: (i) in Hungarian-language programmes, from the academic year 2023/2024: HUF 220,000 per semester, i.e. two hundred and twenty thousand forints; (ii) in English-language programmes, from the academic year 2024/2025: EUR 1,500 per semester, i.e. one thousand five hundred euros (alternatively EUR 150, i.e. one hundred and fifty euros per course per semester, if the student prefers this mode).¹⁰

(5) Students previously enrolled in state-funded programmes who terminated their student status in order to
