Conditions for registering student self-organized groups

According to the Statutes of the Student Government (hereinafter: Statutes), the conditions for the registration of student self-organised groups are laid down in Annex 1 to the Statutes. Accordingly, the Student Representation adopts the following regulation:

5.16 Conditions for Registration

- 5.16.1 A student self-organised group may only be established on the initiative of students with the aim of pursuing jointly one of the following activities:
- 5.16.1.1 professional activity;
- 5.16.1.2 sport activity;
- 5.16.1.3 scientific activity;
- 5.16.1.4 cultural activity.
- 5.16.2 A student self-organised group is required to draw up and adopt its Organizational and Operational Regulations (hereinafter: OOR) at its inaugural meeting. The OOR must include, in particular:
- 5.16.2.1 the group's objectives;
- 5.16.2.2 the field of activity around which the group is organised;
- 5.16.2.3 the conditions and procedure for joining and leaving the group;
- 5.16.2.4 the procedure for electing the leader of the group.
- 5.16.3 A student self-organised group is required to elect a leader.
- 5.13.4 At least 80% of the members of a student self-organised group must be students of the College.
- 5.13.5 The activities of a student self-organised group shall be open to all students of the College.
